CAROLINA SEASONS POA TEMPORARY PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION

RATIONALE:

The Carolina Seasons Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions Article VI, Section 6, Subsection 0 states: "No unlicensed cars or other vehicles shall be stored or left on any property for over 30 days including, but not limited to, recreation vehicles, trailers, campers and boats. Trucks, boats, trailers, self motorized campers and other vehicles may be stored or parked regularly on the premises in garages or other well screened areas. Open parking of these vehicles may be permitted by ... the Property Owners Association in writing for designated areas and designated time periods."

In accordance with the above covenants, the following determinations are made:

- 1. Any unlicensed cars or other vehicles described above, the property owner, will be given 30 days from the date of first notice to get them licensed or removed.
- 2. Duly licensed trucks, boats, trailers, self-motorized campers and other vehicles stored or parked in garages or other well screened areas may do so without issuance of a permit.
- 3. Open parking of said vehicles is, by description in the covenants, temporary in nature and requires a temporary parking permit, with explanation of intentions.

In this regard, the Carolina Seasons Property Owners Association, by board vote, has delegated control to the Architectural Control Committee.
