WELCOME: President Billy Overton called the meeting to order AT 7:05 P.M. EST.

REGULAR SESSION:

- 1) Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting (March 17, 2022):
 - MOTION by Rick to approve the minutes as corrected, **SECONDED** by Charles **VOTE:** Unanimous **IN FAVOR.** Motion was **APPROVED.** Change prepared to proposed and change the voting on community building to a list of names instead of numbers.

2) Treasurer's Report:

- February's revenue is \$35,911 (new dues, builder dues, interest, fees)
- February's expenses were \$2,448 (office supplies, utilities, grounds maintenance)
- Year to Date Income \$45,081
- 224 homes have paid out of the 274 homes in the community (80%)
- 5 properties with multiple years past due and 2 of those are making regular payments
- Adams Homes has paid builders dues for 13 properties that have been cleared/in progress for Phase 2 Section 1
- Sent everything to the auditor for the yearly audit

3) Old Business:

- Front Entrance
 - 1. Have not heard anything from the Groce family
 - 2. Will reach out directly again
- Neighborhood Forum
 - 1. 10 members came and 5 people spoke
 - 2. Will have another next quarter
 - 3. Will put a sign out front as a reminder for the community
 - 4. Answered all the questions and was posted on the website
- Daycare/Wedding Venue
