- Year to Date Expenses \$33,420.27
- Net Income of \$33,593.96
- Total amount in the bank \$181,350.54
- Sent out 29 finance charge invoices at the beginning of the month with 5 already paid.
- May 21<sup>st</sup> is when pool keys will be shut off.
- 3 dates for pool key pickup and past due payments
- CD's- April's (\$20K) will mature and roll over, May's (\$50k & \$30K) will mature, combine, and receive a much higher rate starting in May.
